Mr. Ed Doetzel (APEGA ID: 118094) has been enrolled with APEGA as an Engineer-In-Training since April 26th, 2018, which signifies that Mr. Doetzel has met the academic requirements for registration as a Professional Engineer with the Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Alberta (APEGA).

Mr. Doetzel applied with APEGA in 2010 for enrolment as Engineer-in-Training. The APEGA Board of Examiners assessed Mr. Doetzel 19 technical examinations to meet the academic qualification requirement. Mr. Doetzel was enrolled as a Student Member of APEGA in 2010. 
In addition, Mr. Doetzel wrote and passed the NCEES 'Fundamentals of Engineering' examination, in lieu of writing five of the assessed technical examinations, as allowed by APEGA's Board of Examiners.

Mr. Doetzel has also passed the National Professional Practice Examination (NPPE), which is also a requirement for registration as a Professional Engineer.

Mr. Doetzel is still required to fulfil the experience requirements for registration as a Professional Engineer with APEGA. He must demonstrate eight years of engineering experience acceptable to the Board of Examiners, one year of which must be after completing the technical examinations. The earliest he can apply for professional membership is December 8th, 2018.

Mr. Doetzel will need to update his Work Experience Records after December 8, 2018, and provide appropriate references to support his professional work experience. APEGA staff will review and process this information. The Registration Executive Committee of the Board of Examiners will make a decision on registration of Mr. Doetzel as a Professional Engineer with APEGA.
